**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Entrants will arrive between 9:00 – 10:30 a.m.
2. All cars must be driven under their own power from Schenley Drive onto the show field. The PVGP cannot guarantee the availability of trailer parking. Please contact us in advance if you intend to tow your car to the event.
3. Car Owner or member of immediate family familiar with the operation of the car is required to be with the car at the time of judging and is asked to extend courteous cooperation to all judges.
4. "Rags-down" shall be called at 12:00 p.m. There will be no vehicle preparation or cleaning after the call of "Rags-down". An owner may be penalized or disqualified for violating the call of "Rags-down".
5. Functional mechanicals may be judged at the discretion of the judges. Electrical and mechanical systems shall be operated by the contestant and the Judges shall not be permitted to operate any vehicle.
6. The Hood and Trunk may be left open for display purposes but must be closed at the commencement of judging of individual cars. Judges will request that the Hood and Trunk be opened in the judging process in the Munchener Eleganz Division.
7. Open top cars, convertible and targas, shall be displayed with the roof closed. If applicable, side screens shall be displayed alongside the car.
8. All cars shall be displayed with the side window glass open approximately two inches. Sunroofs shall be displayed half open. Front and Rear vent windows shall be open.
9. Spare tire wells may be inspected and tool kits should be open in Munchener Eleganz Division. If available, original equipment paperwork such as owner's manuals, warranty information, radio cards and documents shall be displayed on the ground at the rear of the vehicles.
10. Entrants are asked to stand back from their vehicle when it is being judged and are asked not to carry on any conversation with the judges unless asked a question by the judges.
11. Any non-automotive objects such as car seats, stuffed animals, trophies, cocktail sets, etc., are to be removed from the car.
12. Only one set of floor mats may be displayed with the vehicle. Floor mats may be left in place but judges may request to look at the floor area under the mats.
13. Any negative comments regarding a competitor's vehicle will not be permitted.
14. Judges are using their reasonable discretion to recognize the owner's effort to maintain originality. Contestants may be asked to disclose any non-original items on the car. Contestants are also free to display restoration photos, historical documents or other materials which display the owner's efforts to maintain the originality of the vehicle and exhibit BMW's heritage.
15. The decision of the judges is final in all divisions & classes. Score sheets shall be made public following awards presentation.
