The entrance to the Cortile is on Northumberland Street, just below the Schenley Park Golf Course clubhouse at the corner of Forbes Avenue and Schenley Drive. Show opens on Saturday at 9:30 AM and cars are displayed until 5:00 PM. Cortile and Grand Prix are held rain or shine. There is no Italian Cortile show on Sunday but you can still park in the same area by bringing your dash card from Saturday. There will be no lunch or access to Pittsburgh Golf Club on Sunday.
