



Application – PVGP Test & Tune Day - Friday, July 16, 2010

REQUIREMENTS

1. Driving suit & safety equipment required for driver per applicable race event.
2. Must have a race-prepared car conforming to the requirements of the sanctioning body conducting your race. (VRG or VSCCA)
3. Must be 18 years or older and have current and valid Road Racing Competition License required per applicable race event.
4. Muffled exhausts required (95 DbA limit or meeting the sound requirements set for the race event).
5. Drivers are responsible for the preparation and safety of their cars in accordance with the competition rules for the applicable race event.
