



2010 Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix Vendor Village Application



Over the past 27 years the Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix has grown to become the country's largest vintage race event. Be a part of this year's event by participating in Vendor Village, an excellent way to reach over 200,000 spectators during our July 24/25 Vintage Race weekend and Car Shows at Schenley Park. Each vendor space measures 15' x 25' deep on the Schenley Park golf course. This dedicated area at the entrance to the Car Show provides an excellent opportunity to display and sell your products. generators, tents, tables and chairs are permitted but not provided.

New for 2010: Vendor spots to sell cars - they are only \$150 each for the weekend.



The addition of the PVGP Historic Races at BeaveRun to our vintage racing schedule provides an opportunity for you to exhibit during the weekend of July 17/18 at the BeaveRun MotorSports Complex in Beaver County, as well as our popular Car Cruise at the Waterfront in Homestead on Tuesday, July 20. Neither location provides electrical power.

----- Spaces at **Schenley Park Race Weekend**, July 24 & 25 (15' wide x 25' deep) Vendors may set-up beginning at noon on Friday July 23 and must clean-up by 7:00 PM Sunday. Sales begin at 10:00 AM and close at 5:00 PM.

\$400.00 for the first space, **\$300.00** for each additional adjacent space.

\$150.00 per vehicle that is for sale. This space is allocated for the car and does not include room for a tent. If you require additional room for a tent or display to sell vehicles you will need to purchase a \$400 spot.

----- Spaces at **PVGP BeaveRun Historic Racing Weekend**, July 17 & 18 (15' wide x 25' deep) Vendors may set-up at 8:00 AM Saturday and clean-up by 7:00 PM Sunday. Sales begin at 10:00 AM and close at 5:00 PM.

\$200.00 for each space, no quantity discounts.

----- Spaces at **Waterfront Car Cruise** in Homestead, Tuesday July 20 5:00 - 9:00 PM. You can set-up at 3:00 PM

\$150.00 for two parking spots, no quantity discounts.
