

2017 PITTSBURGH VINTAGE GRAND PRIX



The Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix Association has a rich history and we are excited to celebrate our 35th Anniversary in 2017. Our two unique race events provide the ideal combination of vintage and historic racing in a 10-day motorsport festival. We kick things off in grand style with a 4-day weekend of vintage sports cars, monoposto and historic race cars on the expanded and challenging Pitt Race Complex. This is followed by a week of motorsport events throughout Pittsburgh, capped off by the nation's only vintage street race through the stone-walled, tree-lined streets of Schenley Park in front of 200,000 enthusiastic fans.

The driving goal of the Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix is to honor our automotive history by encouraging the preservation and racing of vintage cars in a format that emphasizes driver safety and etiquette while presenting a friendly environment for our drivers.

RACE WEEK The Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix has grown into a 10-day celebration of the automobile. Our Race Week activities link the two race weekends, including a black tie gala, a parade through downtown Pittsburgh, a Countryside Tour and a Tune-Up Party that spans the Roberto Clemente Bridge and three distinct car shows. Please join us for all 10 days! We are adding a new event where racers are encouraged to attend – a Jet Center Hangar Party on Thursday, July 13 – right before the Schenley Park Races.

CHARITY The PVGP's mission remains the same as it was in 1983, "To host a world-class vintage race event that celebrates our automotive heritage and raises money for charity." Proceeds benefit the Autism Society of Pittsburgh and Allegheny Valley School. Since 1983 our racers have shared the wheel with the PVGP in donating \$4.5 million to help individuals in Western Pennsylvania affected by autism and intellectual disabilities. Entry fees are suggested donations for participating and are tax deductible.

SANCTIONING The Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix stages and sanctions both race weekends. We welcome licensed drivers from all vintage race organizations to race with us. We want to especially thank our friends at the VRG and the VSCCA who helped establish our races and continue to participate with us on a major scale. DRIVER'S SCHOOL Last year we held a Vintage Driver's School at Pitt Race with the assistance of E. Paul Dickinson. The Track Instruction Program was such a success we have decided to make it an annual event. The \$475 fee is comprehensive and includes all classroom and track time.
